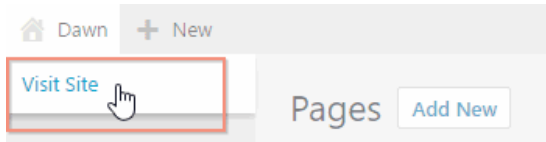


# Explorer website tour

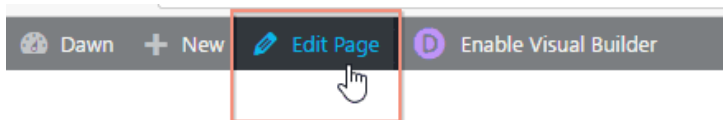
In this guided website tour we will take you by the hand and walk you through the different places of your website, so that you'll familiarize yourself with your new online home. Follow along and explore with us :)

To get started, make sure you are logged in to your website and in the dashboard click "visit site" at the top (CTRL + click to your website in a new browser window). You'll see the dummy content that we've set up for you :)



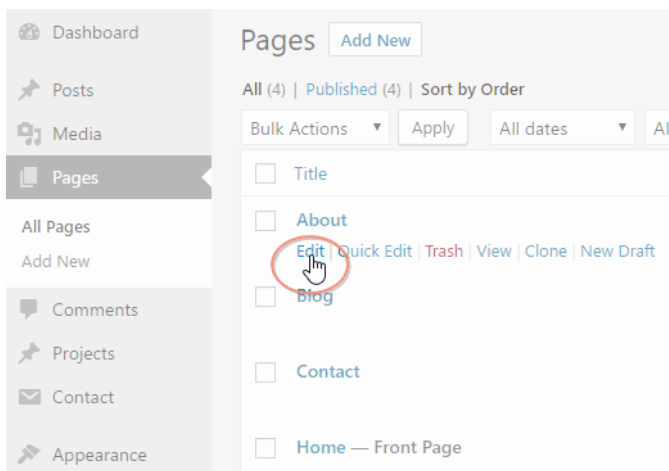
There is a menu with a few items in it, click on one of the pages, for example "contact"...

Click on "edit page" – you are now in the backend of this page. Notice the different modules, the fullwidth map module, and underneath the contact form module, and next to that a text module with a social follow module underneath.

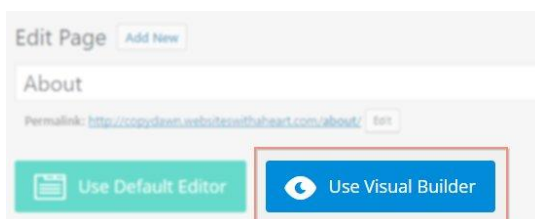


Notice the page title at the top, the publish button on the right and the possibility to change the status of the page from published to draft:

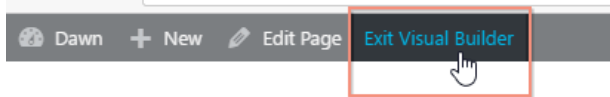
Now go to Pages > All Pages on the left, and find the contact page there also. Now find the "About" page, and click "edit page" now you are in the back end of another page :) notice the modules in the back end builder.



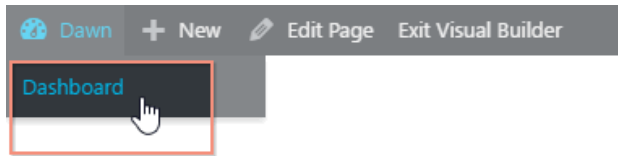
Go to Visual Builder by clicking the Visual Builder button. Notice the same modules but now in the Front end of your website.



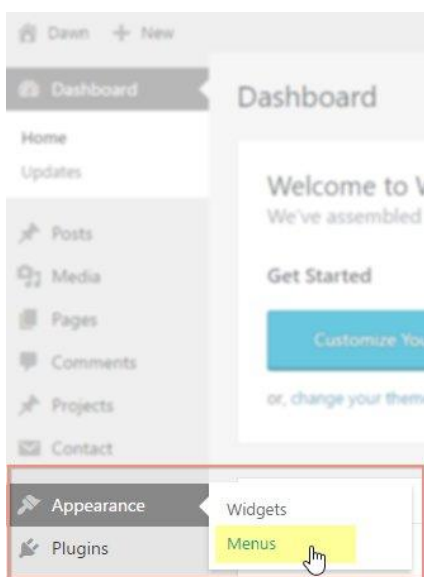
Exit the visual builder by clicking the link button at the top “Exit Visual Builder”.



Go to your menu at the top. Notice the order of the items. Now go to your dashboard again by opening the drop down in the top left and clicking dashboard.



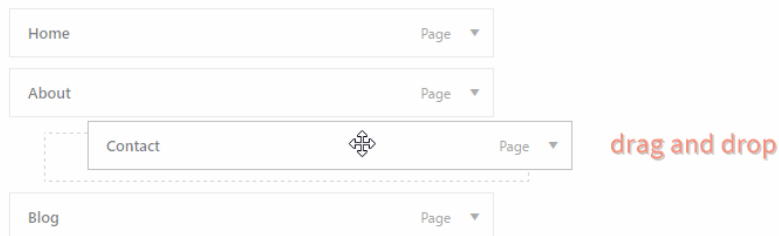
Go to Appearance > Menus (control + click to open in a new window) and notice the menu there.



Try changing the order of your menu items by dragging and dropping them, and click save and see the changes in the front end of your website, by refreshing the page (press F5) that you still had open in the other tab.

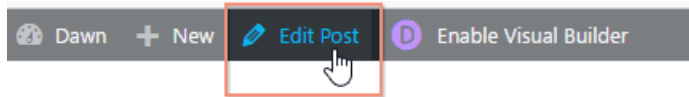
### Menu Structure

Drag each item into the order you prefer. Click the arrow on the right of the item to reveal additional configuration options.

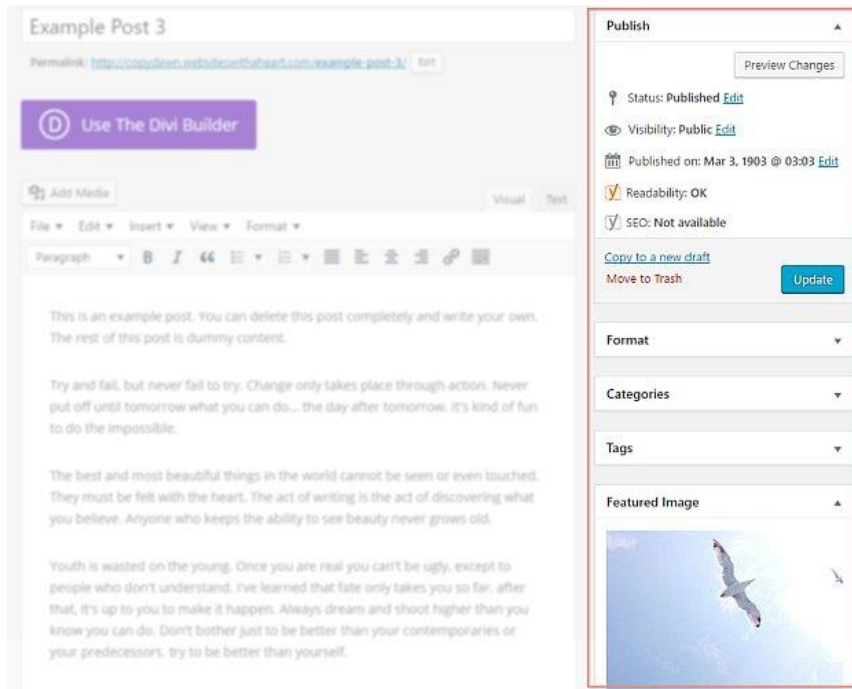


Now go to your blog roll, click on blog in the menu. Scroll down and notice the blog posts in chronological order.

Now click on a post. See how it looks now, with option to leave comments. Go to the admin bar at the top and click “edit post”.

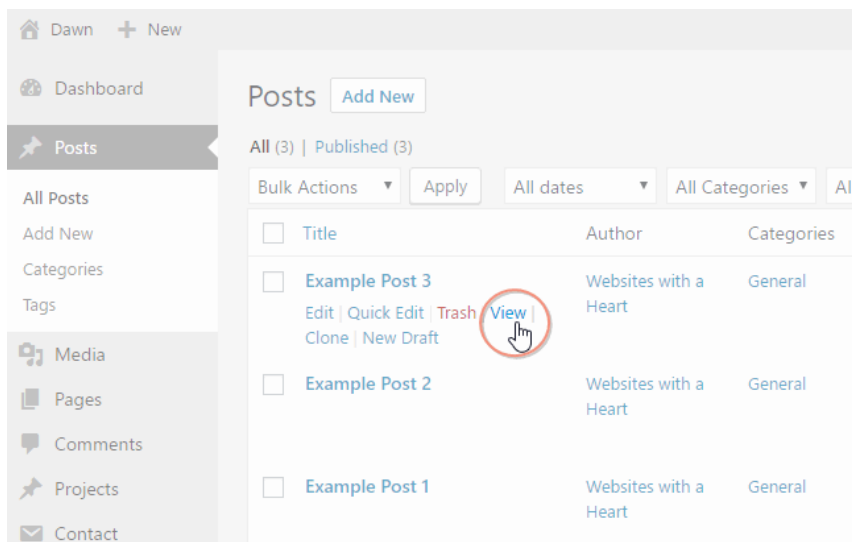


Now you are in the back end of the post. Posts are different from pages. Notice the extra options for blog posts (on the right-hand side of your screen); publishing date, tags, categories, featured image.



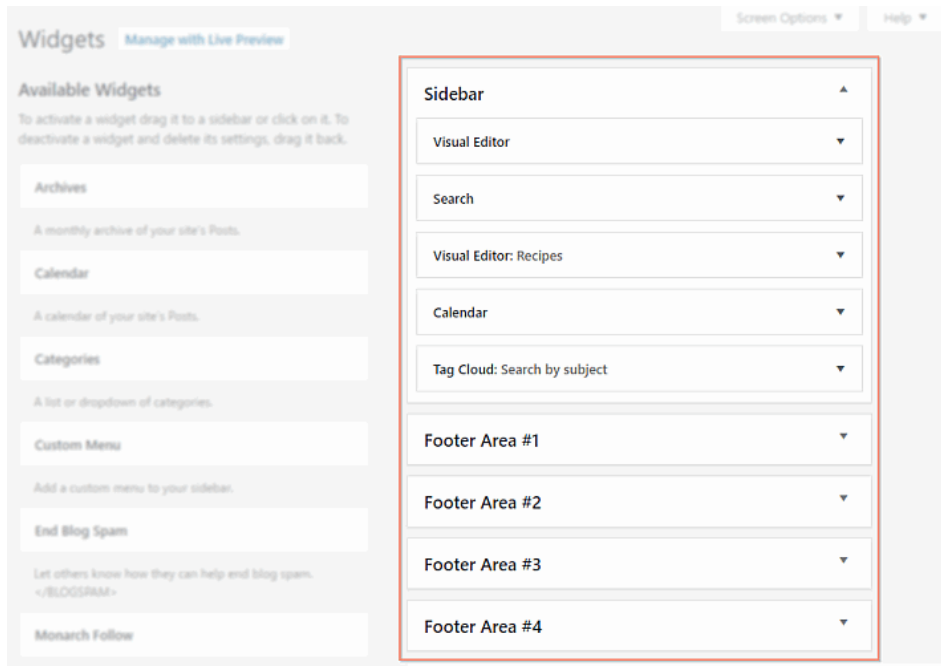
In the menu on the left, go to Posts > My posts. Notice all the posts there and also the options again to edit posts or view them:

Now click “View post” to go to the front end of your website again.

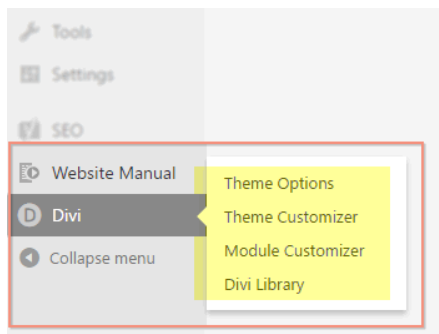


Notice the sidebar next to the blog post. Sidebars and footers are managed in the widget areas. Go to the top left in the admin bar and from the drop down choose Widgets.

Notice the Sidebar widgets, open the items by clicking the arrow on the right. Notice the 4 footer widget areas, 3 are filled with widgets and correspond with the 3 on your site.



Now finally we'd like to show you where the Divi settings are. On the left, scroll down a bit, notice the menu item "Divi" and hover over it to see the Theme options, the Theme Customizer, and the Divi Library at the bottom. You can use these to make changes to the look of your site (but we'll cover that separately).



That's it, you've now had a grand tour of your website, and you should have some basic idea of what's where and how it's set up.

And don't worry if you haven't remembered everything :) In the classes of this course we show you again, this was just an overview to give you a feel for your site!
